Purpose: To review and receive comments on two proposed companion ordinances pertaining to short term rentals. The first ordinance is a proposed Short Term Rental Licensing Ordinance that would define short-term rentals, require licensing for short-term rentals, limit total the number of short-term rental licenses, establish a licensing process including procedures for the suspension or revocation of licenses, outline general regulations for short-term rentals, and prescribe penalties for violations of the ordinance. The second ordinance would amend the Sanilac Township Zoning Ordinance to define short-term rentals, allow short-term rentals in the AR (Agricultural Residential), LR (Lakefront Residential) and C (Commercial) zoning districts, establish separation requirements between short-term rentals, and outline parking requirements for short-term rentals.
